## **Ecology and sustainability at Thomas Walk Vineyard**

Thomas Walk Vineyard differs significantly from conventional viticulture and goes beyond the obligations of organic viticulture. The following table shows the difference between conventional, organic and the viticulture at Thomas Walk Vineyard:
